When determining your academic plan, please consider the following factors:

## Freshman/Sophomore Years

Two semesters of the same foreign language  
College Algebra level completed

## Prerequisites

If a class has a prerequisite, it will appear in the Undergraduate Catalog under the course number.  
Scheduling sequence (ask the department).

## Balance of Units and Types of Classes

Try to limit yourself to one 4-unit course per semester.

## Transferring Units

If you are planning to take summer courses at a community college, remember to have the classes pre-approved by the [Office of the Undergraduate Registrar](#) before you enroll.

## Seasonally Offered Classes

Please keep in mind that not all classes are offered every semester, so you will need to plan ahead for those.
