- A letter to the dean, autobiographical sketch, or letter of intent as required by the program to which you are applying (Verify requirements online at www.apu.edu.)
- Official transcript(s) (An official transcript is one which Azusa Pacific University receives unopened in an envelope sealed by the former institution and which bears the official seal of the college or university. Official transcripts are required for degrees, certificates, and credentials earned prior to application to APU. Official transcripts for other college coursework not leading to a degree, certificate, or credential may be required by the department for program acceptance consideration.)
- Degree Equivalency Report from an APU-approved agency (for international transcripts only)
- Letters of recommendation (Forms are available online at www.apu.edu/apply/forms/.)
