AWARDS: Cash Prizes + Publication Opportunity

- Up to three cash prizes of \$250 each for winning author(s). Co-authored or multiple authored winners will share the prize
- Winning papers will be published in the new Honors Program Journal (*Gratia Eruditionis*, vol. 2)
- Award winners will be recognized at the Common Day of Learning conference — March 3, 2010

ELIGIBILITY: Undergraduate Honors Program Students

- Open to students enrolled in the Honors program (and other students with 6 units of Honors coursework)
- Papers must have been written between January 1, 2009—December 18, 2009

COMPETITION RULES:

- The paper must reflect the author(s) own work
- Students may submit papers written for specific class assignments
- Each student is limited to one paper submission per award cycle
- Maximum paper length is 6,000 words (approximately 22-24 pages)
- Paper abstract must be provided (150 words or less)
- A cover page must include the title of the paper, author(s) full name(s), major, email address, and telephone number
- The paper must be endorsed by a faculty member in a related discipline
- An electronic copy of the paper must be submitted to cdl@apu.edu
- Winners **must** be able to present at the Common Day of Learning event

Please Note:

Judges will review papers in a blind review process and will use scholarly criteria in their deliberations.

Judges reserve the right to not award prizes if papers are not of sufficient quality or number.
