

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Azusa Pacific University **MSOP Impact Scholarship** is intended to assist graduate students who plan to pursue a Master's degree in Organizational Psychology, can indicate an enthusiasm for fostering healthy organizational life, and who demonstrate financial need.

Based on the applicants FAFSA information, a written response, and recommendation of the MSOP Scholarship Committee, the University will award a scholarship having the maximum value of \$1000 to selected recipients. The Scholarship application deadline is **July 1, 2016** for Fall and **December 1, 2016** for Spring.

All scholarship recipients must demonstrate Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP), enroll in courses that are applicable to the MSOP degree program and maintain at least a part-time student status. Scholarship recipients may be asked to participate in a short, annual research survey as part of their scholarship requirements.
