## SPECIAL REQUESTS

Operators have the ability to program jobs with special needs. Using an Exception Program setting, allows the operator to mix one-sided with two-sided copies, add two additional colors during the time of reproduction.

## HOW TO USE THIS EXCEPTION WORKSHEET

Check the documents carefully to determine where exceptions are needed. Follow the example below; list the pages that are considered to be an exception;

- Page No.
- Color of stock - remember you can only use 2 additional color stocks, along with your main paper selection.
- If your document is going to be 2-sided, than all of your 1-sided documents are considered to be an exception.
