## KNOW 2

- Every year students participate in Spiritual Formation Week in which they are introduce to classic spiritual practices which encourage current spiritual formation and equip students with tools for a life of faithful discipleship.
- All new faculty are required to complete a year-long orientation course on faith integration.
- Common Day of Learning, offered annually for both student and faculty participation, offers many sessions related to faith integration.
- There are awards given to faculty annually for "Faith Integration Teacher" and "Faith Integration Researcher."
- The Center for Research in Science (CRIS) provides monthly lectures focused on faith integration.
- Faith Integration concepts have been integrated into the General Studies curriculum, the CMIN 108: Christian Faith, Life, and Ministry course and the Senior Seminar courses.
- Annual faith integration lectures are sponsored by the Center for Research on Ethics and Values (CREV).
- A monthly faith integration newsletter for faculty and staff informs them of events and professional opportunities related to Faith Integration.
- The Office of Christian Leadership and Vocation has a grant to help students explore ways to live out their vocation in service to Christ, the church, and the world.
- Faith Integration mini-seminars are offered every summer for APU faculty.
