- APU's Faculty Senate has a *Diversity Council* which specifically focuses on issues of diversity.
- APU continues to rank highly in *Diverse Magazine's* "Top 100 Degree Producers" in multiple categories for graduating ethnic minority student populations in graduate programs.
- Each summer undergraduate APU student leaders spend a day in *diversity training*.
- During the '09-'10 academic year APU faculty had multiple diversity related presentations at national and international conferences.
- APU's annual *Christians on Diversity in the Academy* (CDA) academic conference is in its third year and has hosted faculty from 50 national and international institutions.
- More than 400 staff, faculty, and administrators have completed APU's 16-hour *Imago Dei* diversity training.
- APU has numerous student ethnic organizations and clubs.
- All new APU full-time staff spend time learning about and discussing God-honoring Diversity as a part of their orientation.
- Unlearn Week occurs each spring and is a time to dissect the concept of racial reconciliation through a series of workshops and educational experiences.
- The School of Education faculty started a diversity committee which continues to look specifically at issues of diversity and integration of diversity within the school
