

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Azusa Pacific University **Ahmanson Foundation Veteran's Scholarship (AFVS)** is intended to assist undergraduate or graduate students who are Post 9/11 VA fund recipients, are pursuing a degree, and demonstrate financial need. The award is not exclusive to tuition charges and can be used toward other educationally related expenses. Based upon the applicant's FAFSA information, written essay, and recommendation of the AFVS Scholarship Committee, the University will award a scholarship having a maximum value of \$2,000 to selected recipients. The application deadlines are as follows:

- **August 3, 2018 for the Fall 2018 award**
- **December 7, 2018 for the Spring 2019 award**
- **April 12, 2019 for the Summer 2019 award**

All scholarship recipients must demonstrate Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and be enrolled in courses that are applicable to their degree program. Scholarship recipients may be asked to submit a written thank you note to the Ahmanson Foundation and attend the Veteran and Cadet Graduation Awards Ceremony as part of their scholarship requirements.

2. All applicants must submit a written essay with this application form, stating their education goals and any extenuating personal/financial circumstances that demonstrate their qualifications as a candidate for the scholarship.
3. All applicants must complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** form at www.fafsa.ed.gov

Federal regulations require that all financial aid resources be coordinated. Students may be eligible for less aid from federal sources based upon receiving the AFVS. Please speak with your Student Account Counselor to clarify any questions regarding the coordinating of the AFVS with other financial aid.
