Kern Center for Vocational Ministry Scholarship Criteria

The KCVM Scholarship is awarded to a selected student who meets the criteria below. The student must:

1. Be preparing to be a vocational pastor in a church in the USA
2. Be recommended by a church leader/pastor AND a professor/teacher
3. Demonstrate financial need
4. Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.25 for coursework completed at APU
5. Be working toward a degree in [Christian Ministries](#), [Youth Ministry](#), [Theology](#), or [Biblical Studies](#).

The total maximum award per student is \$10,000. It is distributed as follows: first year - \$2,000; second and third years - \$4,000/year (if the student continues to meet criteria). The Scholarship Review Committee will make final determinations regarding awards.

Student Responsibilities upon Receiving the KCVM Scholarship

- Serve in ministry at a local church on a regular basis
- Write a brief note of thanks to the donor of this scholarship (wait until instructed to do this)
- Write a one-page reflection, at the end of each school year, on how his/her life and vocational ministry goals have been impacted.
- Attend events designated for scholarship recipients.
- Meet with a Kern Center Pastor-Mentor
