

## New Student Orientation 2009

### **Friday September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009**

This is truly your one stop shop for Orientation. Come to UTCC and begin the check-in process. Below are listed all the stations involved in Orientation Check-In.

1. Orientation Check-In: Receive your orientation packet complete with the schedule of events, your pre-ordered APU t-shirt, meal bracelet, and a few other necessary orientation items.
2. Alpha and Team Transfer groups: Alpha and Team Transfer groups are collections of new students lead by a fellow APU student. Check in here to receive your Alpha or Team Transfer group number.
3. APUNet ID Sign-Up: All students must sign up for an APUNet ID account. The APUNet ID is a student's username and password that provides them access to [home.apu.edu](http://home.apu.edu) which is a student's gateway to online information. It includes the student's email account, course information, library resources, online coursework, class grades, chapel attendance records, transcripts, etc... Please stop by the APUNet ID sign-up tables and make sure you have activated your APUNet ID. You'll be lost without it. Do not leave check-in without signing up.
4. CashNet Sign-Up: All students must sign up for and login to the CashNet website in order to pay university bills online. It is during this time that you may also set up your parent or guardian as an authorize payer.
5. Commuter Student Information: Are you commuting to APU? Please stop by this table to meet current students and staff to get your questions answered and learn of your resources.
6. Transfer Student Information: Are you transferring to APU as a sophomore or higher? Please stop by this table to meet current transfer students and staff to get your questions answered.
7. ID Card Photo and Pick-Up: You may pick up your student ID card if you have previously taken your photo. If you have not yet taken your ID card photo, you can also take care of that here.
