Qualifications:

- Applicants may be newly admitted or continuing students, but should be in good standing with the university and program (not on academic probation).
- A recipient must be enrolled full-time (9 units) in the APU Master’s of Arts in TESOL program during the term in which the award is credited.
- **Stapleton Scholarship:** Preference will be given to female students.
- **Clarke Scholarship:** Preference will be given to international students.

Award Specifics:

- **Stapleton Scholarship:** Each year up to \$500 is awarded to two different recipients.
- **Clarke Scholarship:** Each year up to \$1000 is awarded to two different recipients.
- Each scholarship is a one-time award for one semester, but awardees may reapply for either scholarship in subsequent semesters.
- All applications will be considered for both scholarships.
- Awards will be disbursed directly to the students’ accounts.
