

# PACKING LIST

HOW TO MAKE APU YOUR NEW HOME.



You will want to furnish your new campus home by bringing these items with you. Every student is provided with a bed (most with an XL twin mattress, 36x80), desk, chair, and set of drawers. APU has a relationship with [Campus Comforts](#), a company that offers everything from bedding to other dorm essentials that you may wish to consider as well. Some items prohibited below are primarily for safety considerations and additional information may be found in the Facility Use and Health and Safety sections of the housing policies.

## SLEEP

- Pillow
- Sheets (twin XL)
- Comforter/quilt/duvet cover
- Blanket(s)
- Alarm clock

## STUDY

- Desk lamp
- Wastebasket
- Backpack
- Binders/organizers
- Paper (printer, notebook)
- Desk supplies (writing tools, scissors, stapler, post-its, tape, glue, hole-punch, paper clips, etc.)

## CONNECT

- Surge protector (no extension cords)
- Headphones
- Cell phone, tablet, chargers
- Computer/laptop
- Printer/printer ink

## EAT

- Reusable water bottle
- Food storage containers
- Mini-fridge (must be a "mini" or "compact" fridge)
- Simple appliances w/out open flame (coffee maker, air popcorn popper)

## HEALTH

- Medicine/vitamins (see the Health Center)
- Sunscreen
- First aid kit (small)

## SHOWER

- Bath/beach towels, washcloths
- Shampoo/conditioner
- Body wash/face wash
- Shower caddy/tote
- Shower shoes
- Shower curtain/rod\*

## GROOMING/TOILETRIES

- Toothbrush/paste/dental floss
- Shaving cream/razor(s)
- Hair dryer/curling iron
- Nail clippers/nail file
- Facial tissue/toilet paper\*

## LAUNDRY & CLEANING

- Laundry hamper/basket
- Laundry detergent/softener
- Iron/ironing board
- Clothes hangers
- Vacuum cleaner
- Basic cleaning supplies

## ESSENTIALS

- Clothes
- Keychain/lanyard (\$60 fee for lost dorm key, \$120 for apartment key)
- Poster putty or other removable material (any damage may result in a charge)

## EMERGENCY KIT

We recommend having an emergency kit in your room or car with critical supplies that can help you through an unexpected shelter in place or quick evacuation:

Consider: Bottled water, non-perishable snacks, medicine, medications or prescriptions, cash/coins, first aid supplies, face coverings, flashlight, hand sanitizer, batteries, hygiene items, cell phone chargers, set of clothes, etc.

## APARTMENT SPECIFIC ITEMS

- Couches and/or loveseats
- Coffee tables
- Dinnerware/flatware
- Drinking glasses
- Kitchen table and chairs
- Pots and pans/cooking utensils
- UL-approved appliances -microwave, crock pot, toasters, etc.

**Note:** Campus apartments are furnished with a full-size refrigerator and a stove/oven. Depending upon your assignment, a microwave, dishwasher, and washer/dryer may also be provided. Check the Living Area Pages for amenities in each area.

 **FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS, DO NOT BRING TO:**

## RESIDENCE HALLS

- Any cooking grill tops
- Any open flame appliance or device
- Electric skillets and saucepans
- Microwaves and hot plates
- Oil popcorn poppers
- Toasters or toaster ovens

## APARTMENTS AND RESIDENCE HALLS

- Air conditioners, ceiling fans, space heaters
- Any appliance/device not clearly marked as UL approved
- Pets (see policy on animals)
- Barbeques (some are available on campus)
- Candles or incense
- Items that require nails or screws to mount on walls or ceilings
- Extension cords (surge protectors okay)
- Halogen lamps
- Non-APU bed lofts
- Weapons, alcohol, tobacco
