***SOCW 540 can be taken over summer 2 or in the Spring of Year 3**

***SOCW 563 must be taken in the Fall of Year 3 with your specialization practicum at a school site.** This results in 12 units of enrollment (full time) in Fall of Year 3

You may take additional electives if you wish, but it will be outside of the 60 units required to graduate.
