Key Questions:

Who is involved?

- Event facilitators: Azusa Pacific University, Citrus College, Cal Poly Pomona, in partnership with the Azusa Unified School District
- Event attendees: Center Middle School, Foothill Middle School, Slauson Middle School, Ellington Middle School, and St. Frances of Rome
- Student representatives can receive SERVICE CREDIT for their participation (APU ONLY)

What does it take to make a booth?

- Send 2-3 representatives to educate 8th graders about the major
- Create an interactive activity, 2-3 minutes in length, as a means to introduce students to your particular subject area
- Provide sample textbooks and/or kid-friendly informational flyers about your program

How many hours of participation are expected?

- Major representatives will be on-site for 6.5 hours; students may rotate shifts
- Students who want to participate, but are unavailable on event-day, can volunteer to help with set up the evening prior to the event.
- Student representatives can receive SERVICE CREDIT for their participation (APU ONLY)

Anything else I should know?

- A signed participation agreement is required
- Confirmation of participation should be submitted by November 2
- Set up will take place Thursday, February 25th
