- Affidavit of financial support signed by your sponsor
- □ Official sponsor's bank statement with sufficient funds
- Official transcript(s)\*
- □ A copy of valid passport

\*An official transcript is one which Azusa Pacific University receives unopened in an envelope sealed by the former institution and which bears the official seal of the college or university. APU reserves the right to require transcripts sent directly from the former institution. Transcripts in English and in the original language are required.

#### MINIMUM ENTRANCE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS:

- A minimum GPA of 2.75 for acceptance
- Minimum auditory skill level required (as determined by APU/ALCI proficiency test) to function in ESL classroom
- Minimum oral skill level required (as determined by ALCI proficiency test) to function in ESL classroom

Please note, if you are applying for any degree programs and have already submitted application materials, you will only need to submit an ALCI application.

#### STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT WITH INSTITUTIONAL POLICY

#### Please read and agree to the following by signing below:

As a Christian university, we uphold the following statement of mission and purpose: Azusa Pacific University (APU) is an evangelical Christian community of disciples and scholars who seek to advance the work of God in the world through academic excellence in liberal arts and professional programs of higher education that encourage students to develop a Christian perspective of truth and life. Although students do not have to be Christians, they are encouraged to be open to learning about the Christian faith and expected to uphold the school's policies.

If admitted to APU, you are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of APU as contained in the current Undergraduate Catalog, Student Handbook, and ALCI Student Handbook. If there is a dispute between you and the university, the catalog outlines the procedure for making an appeal. It is your responsibility to review the current Undergraduate Catalog before or after being admitted to the university and to be aware of the policies outlined. The mission of APU includes cultivating in each student not only the academic skills that are required for a university degree, but also the characteristics of academic integrity that are integral to a sound Christian education. A sense of moral responsibility, consistent with the biblical teachings of honesty and accountability, is critical. A breach of academic integrity is viewed as an act which is fundamentally inconsistent with the purpose and mission of the entire university.

APU is also committed to a biblical system of values. Opportunities are available through classes, chapel services, and informal small-group meetings for spiritual discussion, reflection, and decision.
