How to obtain Graduate Housing for Summer 2022

All the details you will need to know!

- Current students should complete the [Graduate Summer Request and License Agreement](#) by April 29, 2022. Those who do not will be required to vacate their assignment by May 8, 2022.
- New students may complete the [Graduate Summer Request and License Agreement](#) to obtain an assignment.



Summer Rates and Details:

University Village



- \$3146 for standard capacity (two students per one-bedroom unit and four students per two-bedroom unit).
- \$4719 for private bedroom capacity (no roommates assigned to the bedroom, you may have others assigned with you in a second bedroom).
- We will continue to offer the 50% discount for summer housing that we offer to undergraduate students (\$1573 for standard and \$2359.50 for private bedrooms).

Private Bedroom Notes

- Private rooms are not guaranteed and are determined by availability.
- As private rooms fluctuate from year to year, the standard two sets of bedroom furniture remain in the room.

Utilities now Included!

- Students no longer have to set up, close, and coordinate payment of utilities services (electricity, gas, and trash).
- The cost for utilities is now included in the housing rate.
- Current Graduate Residents can shut their service off at the end of the spring term.

Graduate Housing Summer Program

Eligibility

Open to graduate students currently living in graduate housing in Bowles and new graduate students seeking housing. Students need to be **enrolled** in graduate-level academic programs on the Azusa Campus (at least one class per traditional academic semester). New students must be enrolled during the summer. Continuing students extending for summer do not need to be enrolled for the summer if they are enrolled for the fall. APU does not currently offer married housing.

Placement and Dates of Term

Summer Graduate Housing will be located in University Village (P & Q). The summer term and check-in starts on Monday, May 9, 2022 at 3pm. Students currently living in Bowles will have until Tuesday May 10 to complete their move. The 13 weeks of summer housing officially ends on August 5 for those who have not secured fall 2022 graduate housing, regardless of when summer classes end.

How to Apply

New and continuing students who need housing for summer 2022 must submit the [Graduate Summer Request and License Agreement](#) by April 29, 2022. Those currently living in graduate housing who do not request a summer extension must checkout and vacate their assignment by May 8, 2022.

Benefits and Amenities

- Close to campus; Apartment living
- Unit includes: Washer/dryer, refrigerator, stove/oven, over the range microwave, dishwasher, twin XL bed, dresser, desk, chair
- Live with fellow APU graduate students (two students per one-bedroom unit and four students per two-bedroom unit)
- Private-bedroom occupancy available if/as enrollment allows
- Access to campus amenities (APU wireless internet access, dining venues, fitness center, recreational areas, libraries, etc.)

Assignment Notifications

Summer assignment notifications will be emailed out on the evening of **May 3, 2022**. Following assignments will be emailed as they are made (usually within 48-72 hours). Students who are placed on a wait list will be notified of their status via email.

Commitment

Students who submit a [Graduate Summer Request and License Agreement](#) make a commitment for the entire 13 weeks of summer housing when they check-in and receive their room key. There is no weekly option for graduate housing.
