



This scholarship is in honor of Kyle Ian MacDonald, alumni (2015) of APU's M.S. in Physical Education program. The intent of this scholarship is to financially support students in the pursuit of teaching and mentoring students through coaching, physical education, exercise science and sport management.

Eligibility

- Admission into the Master of Arts in Physical Education, Master of Science in Physical Education, Master of Science in Physical Education: Sport Management, or Adapted Physical Education Added Authorization program, at a minimum of 15 units per year;
- Be a person of integrity and character who seeks to improve the lives of others through physical education, coaching, athletic administration and exercise science professions, as determined by the selection committee.
- Reflect an understanding of Christ's love and mercy, as determined by the Selection Committee.

Award

- As the endowment earnings allow, one to two scholarships will be awarded annualy, ranging from \$2,500 to \$2,800
- Scholarship posted directly into student account following the last day to enroll in award term
