Prepare for a Life of Impact

Azusa Pacific offers an abundance of resources to equip you for a life of ministry and difference making. A multidisciplinary curriculum creates a broad knowledge base for ministry, while faculty-mentors come alongside you to share their wisdom and experiences. Opportunities for real-world ministry abound, from a weeklong immersion course in Los Angeles to study urban contexts, to a yearlong internship in a church or parachurch organization, to study away opportunities in Israel, South Africa, the High Sierra, and more.
