<p>MLA Style</p>	<p>Parenthetical Citations: The first time you reference a version of the Bible, in the in-text citations, give the name of the edition (<i>italicized</i>), followed by a comma and the abbreviated book (see back of handout), chapter, and verse. Use a period, not a colon, between the chapter and verse: John 3.16.</p> <p>Ezekiel saw “what seemed to be four living creatures” (<i>New Jerusalem Bible</i>, Ezek. 1.5-10).</p> <p>If future references come from the same version of the Bible, include only the abbreviated book, chapter, and verse in the parenthetical citation: “For the Lord your God is bringing you into a good land” (Deut. 8.7).</p> <p>Works Cited Page: Include the name of the Bible (<i>italicized</i>), the editor (if given), and publication information:</p> <p><i>The Student Bible</i>. Ed. Phillip Yancey. New York: Zondervan, 1996. Print.</p>
<p>APA Style</p>	<p>Parenthetical Citations: The first time you reference a version of the Bible, give the book (abbreviated), chapter, and verse, followed by the name of the edition (not italicized) in the in-text citation.</p> <p>Quote: “He who walks with the wise grows wise, but a companion of fools suffers harm” (Prov. 13:20 New International Version).</p> <p>Paraphrase: In Proverbs 13:20 (New International Version), the Bible encourages us to spend time with wise people to become wiser.</p> <p>If future references come from the same version of the Bible, include only the abbreviated book, chapter, and verse in the parenthetical citation: “It was majestic in beauty, with its spreading boughs, for its roots went down to abundant waters” (Ezek. 31:7).</p> <p>Reference List: Do not include biblical references on the reference page unless required by your professor.</p>
<p>Chicago/ Turabian</p>	<p>Footnotes and Endnotes: The first time you reference a version of the Bible, give the book (abbreviated), chapter, and verse, followed by the name of the edition (not italicized) in parentheses:</p> <p>¹ 1 Thess. 4:11 (New Revised Standard Version). For specialist audiences, abbreviate: ¹ 1 Thess. 4:11 (NRSV).</p> <p>If future references come from the same version of the Bible, include only the abbreviated book, chapter, and verse in the footnote or endnote:</p> <p>² Eph. 6:10-17.</p> <p>Bibliography: Do not include biblical references in the bibliography unless required by your professor.</p>
<p>SBL Style Society of Biblical Literature</p>	<p>Parenthetical Citations: The first time you reference a version of the Bible, give the book (abbreviated without a period), chapter, and verse, followed by the abbreviated name of the version (not italicized) in parentheses:</p> <p>“He who walks with the wise grows wise, but a companion of fools suffers harm” (Prov 13:20 NIV).</p> <p>If future references come from the same edition of the Bible, include only the book, chapter, and verse in the parenthetical citation: The events transpired “in the ninth year of King Zedekiah of Judah, in the tenth month” (Jer 39:1).</p> <p>Bibliography: Do not include biblical references in the bibliography unless required by your professor.</p>
