

REPORTING CONCERNS ABOUT THE CARE OR USE OF ANIMALS AT AZUSA PACIFIC UNIVERSITY

The University has established the following mechanisms for reporting animal welfare concerns:

1. Often, the preferred first course of action is to discuss the issue and resolve it on site with the individuals present.
2. If this is not possible or is not successful, a report (anonymous or otherwise) may be submitted to:

Be assured your report will be handled confidentially. All reports will be reviewed and, if warranted, investigated. Corrective action will be taken if deemed necessary. The IACUC will inform you of its findings as appropriate unless your concerns are reported anonymously.

No University employee, IACUC member, or laboratory personnel shall be discriminated against or be subject to any reprisal for reporting, in good faith, a concern or violation of any animal care and use regulations or standards.
