## Eligibility

## **Award**

- Awards are based on the endowed fund amount and may vary year to year. The award is typically \$2,500 and applications are accepted Fall and Spring

## **Application Process**

- Write a two-page, double-spaced essay reflecting commitment to teaching in K-12 public school, and the influence that spiritual growth has had on career goals and dreams

- Application deadline is August 5 for Fall and November 12 for Spring. Applicants will receive notification of the outcome after the committee has met.
