



This scholarship is in honor of William Joseph Watson and Sic Way Wong, to benefit graduate students at Azusa Pacific University studying theology.

Eligibility

- Entering or continuing graduate theology students
- Single parent (due to divorce or death) with at least one child under age of 18 living in the home of the applicant OR child of a single parent (due to divorce or death)
- Aspiring future ministry career goals
- Demonstrated financial need Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Enrolled at least half-time in consecutive Fall and Spring terms of the awards
- Must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress

Award

- As the endowment earnings allow, approximately \$2,000 \$4,000 in scholarships may be awarded annually in increments of \$1,000 \$2,000 per term.
- Scholarship posted directly into student account following the last day to enroll in award term
- You will be asked to write a thank you note to the donor sharing how this scholarship has assisted your educational, vocational, and ministry goals.
- This scholarship may adjust your financial aid offer. For assistance, check with your Student Account Counselor

Application Process

- Write a 500 word essay on your commitment to faith and your vocation, future ministry goals, and how you envision using your skills and education in your future career.
- Share briefly (300 words or less) your history as a single parent or as the child of a single parent.
- Complete this application and return to scholarships@apu.edu
- Application deadline is **November 15**. Applicants will receive notification of award.
