MaryLou completed her APU Master's Degree and was hired as an elementary school counselor. She looks forward to advocating for and supporting students.



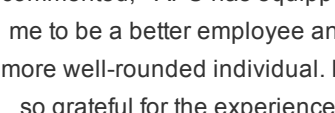
Russell Buhr (2006)

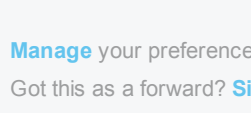
